
4 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
5 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
6 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
7 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
8 unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.

9 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
10 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
11 expended by the appropriate expending agency for the purposes of
12 this Act.

13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
