A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SEVENTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$26,940,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2013-2014
5 for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for
6 the seventeenth senatorial district, as follows:

7 To be expended by the department of education:

8 A. Waipahu high school

9 Design, plans, and construction of
10 an all-weather eight lane track
11 and field; ground and site
12 improvements; equipment and
13 appurtenances.

10 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
 11 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 12 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
 13 provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are
 14 unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.

15 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
 16 agency designated in section 1 for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
