

1 political party. No person shall be elected to the office of
2 lieutenant governor for more than two consecutive full terms.
3 The lieutenant governor shall perform such duties as may be
4 provided by law."

5 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
6 be as follows:

7 "Shall the nominee for lieutenant governor be appointed by a
8 gubernatorial nominee, following the primary election, for
9 the same term and from the same political party as the
10 gubernatorial nominee, rather than be elected in a separate
11 election?"

12 SECTION 4. Constitutional material to be repealed is
13 bracketed and stricken. New constitutional material is
14 underscored.

15 SECTION 5. This amendment shall take effect upon
16 compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the Constitution of
17 the State of Hawaii.
