# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding three new sections to be appropriately  
3 designated and to read as follows:

4           "§302A-       Public school safety. The board, in cooperation  
5 with the police and fire departments of each county, shall adopt  
6 uniform rules, policies, and procedures to identify, report,  
7 track, and respond to threats or potential threats of violence  
8 against students in public schools and implement emergency  
9 procedures to protect students from violence in public schools.

10          §302A-       Bullying policy. The board shall adopt a policy  
11 that prohibits bullying of a student by another student and  
12 shall require the prohibition to be included in the student code  
13 of conduct.

14          §302A-       Behavioral intervention. The board shall develop  
15 and implement programs to identify and assist students with  
16 anger management or alienation issues."



# S.B. NO. 1350

**Report Title:**

Board of Education; School Safety; Bullying; Behavioral Intervention

**Description:**

Requires the board of education in coordination with the police and fire departments of each county to develop and implement measures to protect students in public schools from violence or the threat of violence. Requires the board of education to adopt a policy against school bullying. Requires the board of education to develop programs to assist students who suffer from anger management issues and alienation.
