A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
ELEVENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$27,920,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2013-2014
5 for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for
6 the eleventh senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. To be expended by the department of education:

8 A. Manoa public library

9 Plans, design, and construction
10 for improvements to the parking
11 garage for traffic safety, a
12 public address system for the
13 meeting room, expansion of the
14 photovoltaic rooftop electrical
15 system capacity, addition of
16 exterior seating, installation of
17 a building and parking system,



1 installation of an automatic
 2 ground floor sliding glass door to
 3 comply with ADA, and restroom
 4 improvements.



6 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
 7 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 8 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
 9 provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are
 10 unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.

11 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
 12 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
 13 expended by the designated expending agency for the purposes of
 14 this Act.

15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
