A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FOURTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$5,515,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2013-2014
5 for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for
6 the fourteenth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. To be expended by the department of education:

8 A. Aiea intermediate school

9 Design, construct, and equipment
10 for improvements to the cafeteria
11 stage and support spaces; ground
12 and site improvements; equipment
13 and appurtenances.

14 Design \$ 50,000

15 Equipment \$450,000

16 Construction \$ 60,000

17 Total funding \$560,000

1 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
2 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
3 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
4 provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are
5 unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.

6 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital
7 improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by
8 the designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
