
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The intent of this Act is to incentivize
2 partnership and investment in programs specifically designed to
3 assist the offender population in transitioning to the community
4 in a safe, responsible manner. These programs should include
5 partnership with the department of public safety. Funds will be
6 released upon commitment of matching funds by an outside entity,
7 public or private.

8 The purpose of this Act is to provide matching funds for
9 holistic treatment and support services designed to enable
10 participants from the ex-offender population to achieve self-
11 sufficiency.

12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 to
15 match funds for competitively bid program expenses incurred for
16 reintegration supports, job training, employment placement, and
17 case management for persons convicted of crimes and re-entering



1 the community; provided that the funds shall be released upon
2 the commitment of outside private or public matching funds.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
4 labor and industrial relations for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
