# A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING A GRANT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF A  
COMPREHENSIVE SERVICE CENTER.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a center providing  
2 comprehensive services for deaf, hard of hearing, and deaf-blind  
3 individuals in Hawaii has been the dream of the deaf community  
4 in Hawaii since 1972. The creation of a comprehensive service  
5 center is intended to promote individual growth, social  
6 awareness, productivity, and equality by empowering deaf, hard  
7 of hearing, and deaf-blind persons to be full participants in  
8 Hawaii's overall community.

9           The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the  
10 department of human services as a grant for the establishment  
11 and operation of a comprehensive service center.

12           SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$                    or so  
14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 as a  
15 grant, pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for the  
16 establishment of a comprehensive service center.



1           The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
2 human services for the purposes of this Act.

3           SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general  
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$                    or so  
5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 as a  
6 grant, pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for the  
7 operation of a comprehensive service center.

8           The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
9 human services for the purposes of this Act.

10           SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
