## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONDOMINIUMS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

	DE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NAWAII;
1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that mediation is an
2	informal, inexpensive, and confidential process for resolving
3	disputes quickly. Mediation may be particularly advantageous in
4	a condominium setting because of the potential to preserve or to
5	restore harmony within a condominium community.
6	The legislature further finds that fees paid into the
7	condominium education trust fund come from condominium owners
8	and developers. Dedicating a portion of the fund to support the
9	mediation of condominium related disputes will benefit
10	condominium owners and associations.
11	The purpose of this Act is to:
12	(1) Add support for mediation of condominium related
13	disputes as one of the educational purposes that shall
14	be supported by the condominium education trust fund;
15	(2) Beginning with the July 1, 2015, biennium
16	registration, impose an additional annual condominium
17	education trust fund fee dedicated to supporting
18	mediation of condominium related disputes and specify

1		the total fee into the condominium education trust
2		fund. The additional fee shall be in addition to any
3		fee prescribed by rules adopted by the director of
4		commerce and consumer affairs pursuant to chapter 91,
5		Hawaii Revised Statutes; and
6	(3)	Require the real estate commission to make adjustments
7		to the condominium education trust fund to ensure
8		adequate funds are available for mediation of
9		condominium related disputes and any mediation
10		requests are fully accommodated prior to the
11		commencement of the additional annual condominium
12		education trust fund fee.

- 14 shall be amended to reflect the additional annual condominium
- 15 education trust fund fee required by section 514B-72(a)(2),
- 16 Hawaii Revised Statutes, and paid into the condominium education
- 17 trust fund, established by section 514B-71, Hawaii Revised
- 18 Statutes. On June 30 of every odd-numbered year, any unexpended
- 19 additional amounts paid into the condominium education trust
- 20 fund and initially dedicated to supporting mediation of
- 21 condominium related disputes, as required by section
- 22 514B-72(a)(2), Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be used for

## Report Title:

Condominiums; Condominium Education Trust Fund; Mediation

## Description:

Adds support for mediation of condominium related disputes as one of the educational purposes supported by the condominium education trust fund. Beginning with the July 1, 2015, biennium registration, imposes an additional annual condominium education trust fund fee dedicated to supporting mediation of condominium related disputes. Specifies the total fee payable into the condominium education trust fund. Requires the real estate commission to make adjustments to the condominium education trust fund to ensure adequate funds are available for mediation of condominium related disputes and any mediation requests are fully accommodated prior to the commencement of the additional annual condominium education trust fund fee. Effective 07/01/50. (SD2)
