A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO A MEMORIAL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The freedom and security that United States
- 2 (U.S.) citizens enjoy today are direct results of the sacrifices
- 3 and continued vigilance of the U.S. armed forces over the course
- 4 of our nation's history. The sacrifices of the members of the
- 5 U.S. armed forces have preserved the liberties of this nation
- 6 that have made it unique in the world community. Members of the
- 7 U.S. armed forces engaged in the Persian Gulf War, from
- 8 August 2, 1990, to February 28, 1991, which culminated in the
- 9 liberation of Kuwait from Irag. The U.S. air-and-land conflict,
- 10 known as Operation Desert Storm, began on January 17, 1991, and
- 11 lasted through April 11, 1991. Operation Iraqi Freedom was a
- 12 military campaign led by U.S. troops that began on March 20,
- 13 2003, and lasted through August 31, 2010. It was later named
- 14 "Operation New Dawn" on September 1, 2010. Also known as the
- 15 "War in Afghanistan", Operation Enduring Freedom is an ongoing
- 16 war effort that began on October 7, 2001. Members of the U.S.
- 17 Armed Forces also engaged in the Global War on Terrorism,
- 18 Homeland Defense, Operation Noble Eagle, and protected our SB551 SD2 LRB 13-1862.doc



- 1 borders by land, sea, and air. On July 24, 1994, Hawaii
- 2 dedicated the Korean and Vietnam Memorial on the grounds of the
- 3 State Capitol. Thus, it is both fitting and necessary for the
- 4 State to give tangible and visible recognition of the sacrifices
- 5 and contributions of veterans from Hawaii who served in the
- 6 Persian Gulf War, Operation Desert Storm, Operation Iraqi
- 7 Freedom, Operation Enduring Freedom, Operation New Dawn, Global
- 8 War on Terrorism, Homeland Defense, Operation Noble Eagle, and
- 9 who protected our borders by land, sea, and air.
- 10 SECTION 2. The office of veterans' services, with the
- 11 assistance of the department of accounting and general services
- 12 and the department of defense, shall develop a plan to establish
- 13 a memorial honoring the veterans of the Persian Gulf War,
- 14 Operation Desert Storm, Operation Iraqi Freedom, Operation
- 15 Enduring Freedom, Operation New Dawn, Global War on Terrorism,
- 16 Homeland Defense, and Operation Noble Eagle, and those who have
- 17 protected our borders by land, sea, and air, in the historic
- 18 district of Honolulu.
- 19 A public hearing shall be held to receive comments or input
- 20 from interested organizations and residents.
- 21 SECTION 3. The office of veterans' services, with the
- 22 assistance of the department of accounting and general services



- 1 and department of defense, shall submit a report of the findings
- 2 and recommendations to the legislature no later than January 1,
- 3 2014.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Description:

Directs the office of veterans services, with the assistance of DAGS and state DOD, to develop a plan to establish a memorial honoring the veterans of the Persian Gulf War, Operation Desert Storm, Operation Iraqi Freedom, Operation Enduring Freedom, Operation New Dawn, Global War on Terrorism, Homeland Defense, Operation Noble Eagle, and border patrol. Requires a report to the Legislature. Effective 7/1/50. (SD2)
