## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 304A-2153, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) There is established the University of Hawaii tuition
4	and fees special fund into which shall be deposited all revenue
5	collected by the university for regular, summer, and continuing
6	education credit tuition, tuition-related course and fee
7	charges, and any other charges to students, except as provided
8	by law. Moneys deposited into the fund shall be expended to
9	maintain or improve the university's programs and operations
10	[and]. Moneys deposited into the fund shall not be:
11	(1) Expended on executive and managerial positions with
12	salaries of \$150,000 or more;
13	$[\frac{(1)}{(2)}]$ Used as a justification for reducing any budget
14	request or allotment to the university unless the
15	university requests [such] a reduction;
16	$\left[\frac{(2)}{(3)}\right]$ Transferred unless otherwise authorized by the
17	legislature; [and] or

1 [(3)] (4) Restricted by the governor or the director of
2 finance without the prior approval of the legislature.
3 Any rule, policy, or action of any agency or individual in
4 contravention of this subsection shall be void as against public
5 policy."
6 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
