- 1 SECTION 1. Section 708-8305, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "[+1\$708-8305[+] Unlicensed contractor fraud; valuation of property. (1) For purposes of unlicensed contractor fraud, the 4 5 value of the property shall be the greater of: The value of property as provided in section 6  $[\frac{(1)}{(1)}]$  (a) 7 708-801; or The total value of all moneys and any assets of 8  $[\frac{(2)}{(2)}]$  (b) 9 value paid or lost by the victim or victims pursuant 10 to the same scheme or course of conduct. 11 (2) The value of any work done by the unlicensed contractor shall not be used as an offset for the value of the 12 13 property calculated under this section." 14 This Act does not affect rights and duties that SECTION 2. matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 15 16 begun before its effective date. 17 Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
