A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 155D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended a	s follows:
3	1.	By amending subsection (a) to read:
4	"(a)	Applications for grants by qualified producers shall
5	be submit	ted [+]on[+] a form furnished by the department and
6	shall be	filed with accompanying documentation of animal feed
7	costs; pr	ovided that:
8	(1)	The applicant shall comply with applicable federal and
9		state laws prohibiting discrimination against any
10		person on the basis of race, color, national origin,
11		religion, creed, sex, age, sexual orientation, or
12		disability;
13	(2)	The applicant shall have applied for or received all
14		applicable licenses or permits;
15	(3)	The applicant shall indemnify and hold harmless the
16		State and its officers, agents, and employees from all
17		claims arising out of or resulting from the feed
18		purchased;



1	(4)	The subsidy shall not be allowed within a fiscal
2		quarter if the flock or herd size falls five per cent
3		or more below the required minimum of:
4		(A) Three thousand birds;
5		(B) Three hundred fifty cows;
6		(C) Fifty sows in any two months of the applicable
7		fiscal quarter; or
8		(D) One hundred finished beef cattle annually;
9	(5)	The grant shall not exceed a total of [\$250,000]
10		\$200,000 per qualified producer per year; and
11	(6)	The department may request an applicant to provide
12		necessary information for the purposes of verifying
13		flock or herd size and feed purchases."

13	SECT	ION 2. Section 141-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
14	amended by	y amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
15	"(c)	Subject to legislative appropriation, moneys in the
16	special f	und may be expended for the following purposes:
17	(1)	The awarding of grants to farmers for agricultural
18		production or processing activity[+], including grants
19		awarded through the livestock revitalization program
20		authorized by chapter 155D;
21	(2)	The acquisition of real property for agricultural
22		production or processing activity;

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1	(3)	The improvement of real property, dams, reservoirs,
2		irrigation systems, and transportation networks
3		necessary to promote agricultural production or
4		processing activity, including investigative studies
5		to identify and assess necessary improvements to dams,
6		reservoirs, irrigation systems, and transportation
7		networks;
8	(4)	The purchase of equipment necessary for agricultural
9		production or processing activity;
10	(5)	The conduct of research on and testing of agricultural
11		products and markets;
12	(6)	The funding of agricultural inspector positions within
13		the department of agriculture;
14	(7)	The promotion and marketing of agricultural products
15		grown or raised in the State;
16	(8)	Water quality testing and improvement; and
17	(9)	Any other activity intended to increase agricultural

21	SECT	ION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
22	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
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- 1 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
- 2 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 3 year 2014-2015 to be deposited in the agricultural development
- 4 and food security special fund to disburse to qualified
- 5 producers of milk, pork, eggs, poultry, and beef, for the cost
- 6 of feed for beef cattle, dairy cows, hogs, or poultry and to
- 7 provide for the administrative costs of the livestock
- 8 revitalization program.
- 9 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 10 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013;
- 14 provided that the amendments made to section 141-10(c), Hawaii
- 15 Revised Statutes, set forth in section 2 of this Act shall be
- 16 repealed on June 30, 2015, pursuant to Act 73, Session Laws of
- 17 Hawaii 2010.

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Report Title:

Livestock Revitalization Program; Subsidy; Appropriation; Barrel Tax

Description:

Caps the livestock revitalization program grant per qualified producer per year at the lesser of \$200,000 or fifteen per cent of the cost of feed for production of poultry products, milk, or pigs and beef cattle raised and slaughtered in Hawaii for local consumption. Appropriates funds for the livestock revitalization program. Requires the livestock revitalization program to be funded through the environmental response, energy, and food security special fund.

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
