13	<u>(5)</u>	Sell, lease, rent, hold, maintain, use, and operate
14		any property, real, personal, or mixed, tangible or
15		intangible, in support of its purposes, powers, and
16		programs; provided that the sale of real property
17		shall be subject to legislative approval;

1	<u>(6)</u>	Receive by gift, grant, devise, bequest, or otherwise
2		from any source, any property, real, personal, or
3		mixed, intangible or tangible, absolutely or in trust,
4		to be used and disposed of, either the principal or
5		the income thereof, for the benefit only of the
6		residents assisted by its programs; provided that no
7		gift to the authority that has an estimated value of
8		\$1,000 or more shall be accepted unless approved or
9		confirmed by the board; and
10	<u>(7)</u>	Engage the services of volunteers as deemed
11		appropriate by the authority without regard to chapter
12		76, 89, 90, 103, or 103D."
