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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII INTERAGENCY COUNCIL ON HOMELESSNESS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1       SECTION 1. Section 346-382, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended as follows:

3       1. By amending subsection (a) to read:

4       "(a) The Hawaii interagency council on homelessness shall  
5 be composed of the following members or the member's designee:

6       (1) Governor's coordinator on homelessness, who shall  
7       serve as chair;

8       (2) Director of human services;

9       (3) Administrator of the homeless programs office of the  
10       department of human services;

11       (4) Director of health;

12       (5) Director of labor and industrial relations;

13       (6) Director of public safety;

14       (7) Director of business, economic development, and  
15       tourism;

16       (8) Chairperson of the Hawaiian homes commission;

17       (9) Adjutant general;



- 1 (10) Chairperson of the board of trustees of the office of  
2 Hawaiian affairs;
- 3 (11) Attorney general;
- 4 (12) Superintendent of education;
- 5 (13) [~~One member~~] Two members of the house of  
6 representatives to be designated by the speaker of the  
7 house of representatives[+], of whom one member shall  
8 be designated by the speaker of the house of  
9 representatives to serve as an alternate member on the  
10 Hawaii interagency council on homelessness to serve in  
11 the other member's absence;
- 12 (14) [~~One member~~] Two members of the senate to be  
13 designated by the president of the senate[+], of whom  
14 one member shall be designated by the president of the  
15 senate to serve as an alternate member on the Hawaii  
16 interagency council on homelessness to serve in the  
17 other member's absence;
- 18 (15) The mayor of each county;
- 19 (16) A representative of the continuum of care programs in  
20 each county, to be designated by the respective  
21 mayors;



1 (17) A representative of the United States Department of  
2 Veterans Affairs who shall be requested to serve by  
3 the governor;

4 (18) A representative from the Office of Community Planning  
5 and Development, United States Department of Housing  
6 and Urban Development, who shall be requested to serve  
7 by the governor;

8 (19) A representative of a faith-based organization with  
9 interfaith relationships, to be designated by the  
10 governor; and

11 (20) A representative of the business community, to be  
12 designated by the governor."

13 2. By amending subsection (c) to read:

14 "(c) [~~¶¶~~] Except as provided in subsections (a)(13) and  
15 (a)(14), if a member of the Hawaii interagency council on  
16 homelessness [~~member~~] is unable to attend a meeting, that member  
17 may appoint a designee to attend and to act on the member's  
18 behalf during the meeting."

19 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
20 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

21 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
