## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INFORMATION SHARING.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Information created and maintained by the State
- 2 is public property for the benefit of Hawaii's residents. A
- 3 cooperative culture among departments and agencies will
- 4 encourage responsible sharing of information and the removal of
- 5 barriers preventing departments from obtaining necessary data.
- 6 Proper procedures for sharing information will maximize
- 7 departmental knowledge while balancing the need for security and
- 8 privacy of non-public information.
- 9 The legislature finds that creating an environment to
- 10 increase the sharing of information among departments and
- 11 agencies will benefit the State and its citizens by improving
- 12 decision-making, supporting business process improvement,
- 13 reducing redundancy, minimizing errors, and creating a more
- 14 responsive service to the needs of citizens.
- 15 SECTION 2. Chapter 27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 16 by adding a new section to part VII to be appropriately
- 17 designated and to read as follows:

2	improve g	overnment operations. (a) Departments and agencies

4	as prohib	ited by state and federal law.	
5	(b)	The chief information officer shall oversee the	
6	sharing o	f information among departments and agencies and shall	
7	develop p	olicies, procedures, processes, and direct paperless	
8	initiativ	es necessary to effectuate this section, including:	
9	(1)	The time and manner of disclosing information;	
10	(2)	The disclosure and nondisclosure of confidential	
11		information protected by federal or state law; and	
12	(3)	The policies and procedures a disclosing department or	
13		agency may use to prevent a recipient department or	
14		agency from redistributing information.	
15	(c)	Departments and agencies may:	
16	(1)	Share information without entering into a written	
17		agreement; and	
18	(2)	Retain custodial ownership of any information provided	
19		to other departments or agencies.	
20	(d)	The originating department that collects and generates	
21	the infor	mation and data as part of its operations shall remain	
22	the autho	ritative source and custodian for legal proceedings.

1 (e) Nothing in this section shall limit or minimize the 2 respective departments' responsibility for protecting private or 3 confidential information and data as protected against 4 disclosure by federal or state laws. 5 (f) Information shall be shared using appropriate 6 information security protocols, established by the chief 7 information officer, to ensure that the information will be 8 accessible only by authorized personnel." 9 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and 12 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 13 year 2014-2015 for departments and agencies to share information 14 to improve government operations. 15 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 16 of accounting and general services for the purposes of this Act. 17 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
