BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

9	(1) The nonresident military spouse is married to the

13	component of any of the armed forces of the
14	United States; and
15	(B) Stationed in Hawaii pursuant to military orders
16	issued by the United States Department of
17	Defense.
