SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DIRECTOR OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND
TOURISM TO DISSOLVE THE HAWAII FILM OFFICE AND ESTABLISH
THE CREATIVE MEDIA ARTS AUTHORITY.

1 WHEREAS, the State needs an agency with the flexibility to
2 review state assets that are suitable for use as movie or
3 television production sets; and

5 WHEREAS, the State also needs an agency with the authority
6 and capability to lease and process fees for the lease of state
7 assets as movie or television production sets; now, therefore,

9 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-seventh
10 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2013, the
11 House of Representatives concurring, that the Director of
12 Business, Economic Development, and Tourism is urged to dissolve
13 the Hawaii Film Office and establish an agency to be known as
14 the Creative Media Arts Authority with the flexibility to review
15 state assets that are suitable for use on movie or television
16 production sets and authority to lease and process fees for the
17 lease of state assets as movie or television production sets;
