SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO CONDUCT A NEEDS-BASED ASSESSMENT AND A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR A NEW SCHOOL IN HAWAIIAN PARADISE PARK.

1 WHEREAS, according to the 2010 U.S. Census, the population
2 of Hawaiian Paradise Park in the County of Hawaii grew from
3 7,051 to 11,404, or 61.7 percent, between 2000 and 2010; and

5 WHEREAS, access to early childhood education and learning
6 opportunities in nearby elementary schools can play a vital role
7 in helping young children build a strong educational foundation;

10 WHEREAS, Hawaiian Paradise Park's population growth has
11 increasingly strained the elementary schools serving Hawaiian
12 Paradise Park; now, therefore,

14 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-seventh
15 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2013, the
16 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of
17 Education is requested to conduct a needs-based assessment and a
18 feasibility study for a new elementary school serving Hawaiian
19 Paradise Park; and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Education is
22 requested to submit the findings and recommendations of its
23 assessment and study, including any proposed legislation, to the
24 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
25 the Regular Session of 2014; and

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
28 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the
