SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO MAINTAIN, MONITOR, AND ENFORCE ANTI-BULLYING, ANTI-CYBERBULLYING, ANTI-HARASSMENT, AND ANTI-DISCRIMINATION POLICIES AND PROCEDURES TO PROTECT PUBLIC AND CHARTER SCHOOL STUDENTS.

WHEREAS, all students have the right to participate fully in the education process, free from bullying, cyberbullying, harassment, and discrimination; and

WHEREAS, a safe and civil environment in school is necessary for students to learn and to meet high academic standards; and

WHEREAS, bullying, cyberbullying, harassment, and discrimination, like other disruptive or violent behaviors, are forms of conduct that disrupt a student's ability to learn and a school's ability to educate its students in a safe environment;

WHEREAS, because students learn by example, school administrators, faculty, staff, volunteers, and third party contractors and hires should be expected to demonstrate appropriate behavior, treat others with civility and respect, and refuse to tolerate bullying, cyberbullying, harassment, and discrimination: and

WHEREAS, the State has a responsibility to provide a safe and respectful learning environment in which all members of the school community, no matter their differing beliefs, . characteristics, and backgrounds, are treated with dignity and respect, in order to realize their full potential; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2013, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Board of Education
