SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A SUNRISE REVIEW OF THE
REGULATION OF CHECK CASHERS.

1 WHEREAS, S.B. No. , introduced during the 2013 Regular
2 Session, proposes the regulation of check cashers; and

3
4 WHEREAS, persons who hold themselves out as check cashers
5 are not presently required to be registered or otherwise
6 regulated by the State; and

7
8 WHEREAS, section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires
9 certain regulatory measures to be referred to the Auditor for
10 analysis if the regulatory measures being considered for
11 enactment would subject unregulated profession and vocations to
12 licensing upon enactment; and

13
14 WHEREAS, section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, further
15 requires that referral to the Auditor shall be by a concurrent
16 resolution that identifies a specific legislative bill to be
17 analyzed; now, therefore,

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-seventh
20 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2013, the
21 House of Representatives concurring, that in accordance with
22 section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the Auditor is
23 respectfully requested to conduct a sunrise review of the
24 regulation of check cashers; and

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is further
27 requested to submit findings and recommendations, including any
28 proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty
29 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2014; and



1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this
2 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor.
