
SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII TOURISM AUTHORITY TO PRODUCE A
RECREATIONAL SAFETY VIDEO FOR VISITORS AND WORK WITH
AIRLINE COMPANIES, HOTELS, AND OTHER COMPANIES IN THE
VISITOR INDUSTRY TO PROMOTE THE SHOWING OF THE VIDEO.

1 WHEREAS, according to the Department of Health in a
2 February 7, 2013, article in the *Honolulu Star Advertiser*, two
3 hundred eighty-eight nonresidents and two hundred forty-nine
4 Hawaii residents drowned in the ocean between 2002 and 2011; and
5

6 WHEREAS, so far this year, at least a dozen Hawaii visitors
7 have been killed in accidents, including drowning, and on Kauai
8 alone, at least six tourists have drowned; and
9

10 WHEREAS, 2013's pace of accidental deaths is relatively
11 high for Hawaii, which usually sees approximately sixty to
12 seventy accidental deaths among nonresidents a year; and
13

14 WHEREAS, the high number of deaths in the beginning of 2013
15 follows an increase in visitor fatalities in recent years -
16 something officials say is likely due to several factors,
17 including tourists searching out remote areas to explore or
18 overestimating their swimming abilities in unfamiliar ocean
19 currents; and

21 WHEREAS, visitors to Hawaii should be encouraged to educate
22 themselves about the State's natural attractions and beautiful
23 beaches to ensure a safe and enjoyable vacation; and

25 WHEREAS, state and county agencies, as well as the hotel
26 industry, often provide brochures and pamphlets to visitors with
27 tips for traveling safely in the islands; and

29 WHEREAS, airlines are key players in the Hawaii visitor
30 experience and could also help share the important message of
31 ocean safety with the millions of visitors who arrive in the
32 State each year; now, therefore,

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-seventh
2 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2013,
3 that the Hawaii Tourism Authority is requested to produce a
4 recreational safety video for visitors; and

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii Tourism Authority is
7 requested to work with airline companies, hotels, and other
8 companies in the visitor industry to promote the showing of the
9 video; and

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this
12 Resolution be transmitted to the Executive Director of the
13 Hawaii Tourism Authority, who, in turn, is requested to transmit
14 copies to each manager of Hawaii operations for all airlines
15 operating inbound passenger flights to Hawaii, Hawaii hotels,
16 and other companies in the visitor industry.
