SENATE RESOLUTION

DESIGNATING OCTOBER 2 OF EACH YEAR AS THE "INTERNATIONAL DAY OF
NON-VIOLENCE" IN HAWAII IN HONOR OF MAHATMA GANDHI ON HIS
BIRTH DATE.

1 WHEREAS, violence can occur within the family, the
2 workplace, governments, and society, and include crimes of hate
3 and passion, with racial massacres, and against poor and weak
4 minorities and cultures; and
5

6 WHEREAS, many cultures and societies around the world are
7 too quickly resort to violent action to resolve differences or
8 obtain a desired result, which causes too many lives to be hurt
9 or lost; and
10

11 WHEREAS, Mahatma Gandhi believed that the way to resolve
12 conflict is with non-violence; and
13

14 WHEREAS, Mahatma Gandhi urged humankind to make the
15 herculean effort to raise themselves to the next level of human
16 development by embracing and practicing non-violence; and

18 WHEREAS, Mahatma Gandhi's philosophy and strategy for
19 social change rejects the use of violence, but at the same time
20 sees non-violent action as an alternative to passive acceptance
21 of oppression; and

23 WHEREAS, non-violence should be a way of life, and public
24 awareness of non-violence should be taught and demonstrated at
25 every age level and socio-economic status; and

27 WHEREAS, observation of an international day of non-
28 violence in Hawaii on the birth date of Mahatma Gandhi on
29 October 2 acknowledges the great works of one of mankind's
30 greatest peace advocates; now, therefore,

32 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-seventh
33 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2013,
34 that October 2 of each year be observed in Hawaii as the





1 "International Day of Non-Violence" in honor of Mahatma Gandhi
2 on his birth date; and

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the International Day of Non-
5 Violence be used to raise awareness of non-violence and reduce
6 psychological and physical violence in all forms and at all
7 levels; and

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
10 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Dr. Martin Luther
11 King Jr. Coalition-Hawaii, Domestic Violence Action Center,
12 Honpa Hongwanji Mission of Hawaii, Inclusive Orthodox Church,
13 LOTUS, Central Union Church in Honolulu, Iolani Peace Institute
14 of Honolulu, and Center for Global Nonkilling.
