H.B. No. 1380 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII,"

The purpose of this measure is to help increase access for  
Hawaii residents who are students to educational and civic  
opportunities by appropriating \$200,000 in general revenues for  
each fiscal year of fiscal biennium 2013-2015, for the University  
of Hawaii to implement a scholarship program, with specified  
requirements, in partnership with the Washington Center.

The Student Equity Excellence and Diversity Office of the  
University of Hawaii at Manoa and a concerned individual supported  
this measure. The University of Hawaii provided comments.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:


- (1) Allowing appropriated monies to be used for other
