Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 20
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR STATE
LIFEGUARDS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to protect public health and
safety and allow the public to enjoy the natural beauty of Hawaii
by appropriating funds for the employment of lifeguards, including
salaries and benefits, at Kua Bay, Kekaha Kai State Park on the
Island of Hawaii.

The Department of Land and Natural Resources and Division of
State Parks commented on this bill.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:


- (1) Changing the appropriation amount for salaries,
benefits, equipment, and other related expenses for the
employment of lifeguards by the Department of Land and
Natural Resources on the Island of Hawaii from \$200,000
to an unspecified amount;
- (2) Changing its effective date to July 1, 2030, to
encourage further discussion; and



- (3) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Finance that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 20, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Third Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 20, H.D. 1.
