Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 816  
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR COLLECTIVE  
BARGAINING COST ITEMS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to appropriate funds for  
collective bargaining cost items for public employees in  
collective bargaining unit (1) and their excluded counterparts.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure  
from the Department of Budget and Finance; the University of  
Hawaii System; and the United Public Workers, AFSCME Local 646,  
AFL-CIO.

Your Committee finds that this measure promotes effective and  
orderly government operations by providing funds to cover the  
expected costs of implementing the collective bargaining agreement  
currently being negotiated between the State and the exclusive  
representative of collective bargaining unit (1).

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your  
Committee on Finance that is attached to this report, your  
Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 816  
and recommends that it pass Third Reading.
