Sir:

Your Committee on Health, to which was referred H.B. No. 893
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE DIETITIAN LICENSURE
SPECIAL FUND,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to provide clarifications for
expenditures relating to the dietitian licensure special fund.

More specifically, the measure:

- (1) Limits to \$30,000 the amount the Department of Health
may spend from the dietitian licensure special fund per
year for activities associated with administering the
licensure program;
- (2) Requires that any amount in excess of \$35,000 in the
dietitian licensure special fund at the end of each
fiscal year be deposited into the general fund; and
- (3) Requires the Department of Health to submit an annual
report to the Legislature regarding the status of the
dietitian licensure special fund.

Your Committee received testimony in support from the
Department of Health and the Hawaii Dietetic Association.



Your Committee finds that these amendments will establish necessary expenditure limits for the dietitian licensure special fund that will allow the Department of Health to support the dietitian licensure program while providing for responsible expenditure of special fund moneys.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Health that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 893 and recommends that it pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Consumer Protection & Commerce.


