Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 898  
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO PARKED VEHICLES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to repeal unnecessary  
rulemaking provisions in the Hawaii Revised Statutes by removing  
the Department of Health's authority to adopt rules pertaining to  
human habitation within vehicles parked on roadways, streets,  
highways, or other public property between 6:00 p.m. and 6:00  
a.m.; or while the vehicle is parked on private property without  
proper authorization.

The Department of Health and a concerned individual testified  
in support of this bill.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your  
Committee on Finance that is attached to this report, your  
Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 898  
and recommends that it pass Third Reading.
