Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred  
H.C.R. No. 142 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF  
TRANSPORTATION TO EXAMINE ALTERNATIVE WAYS TO REDESIGN THE H-  
1/H-2 FREEWAY MERGE TO ALLEVIATE TRAFFIC CONGESTION,"

The purpose of this measure is to alleviate traffic  
congestion by urging the Department of Transportation to:

- (1) Study alternative ways to alleviate eastbound traffic  
congestion on the H-1/H-2 freeway, particularly near the  
H-1/H-2 merge; and
- (2) Submit a report based on its study, which includes any  
findings, recommendations, and necessary legislation, to  
the Legislature no later than 20 days prior to the  
convening of the Regular Session of 2014.


The Department of Transportation opposed this measure.
