Your Committee on Education, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 71, H.D. 1, entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO SUPPORT A STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM FOR STUDENTS IN HAWAII PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND STUDENTS IN PROVINCES IN THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES WITH WHICH THE STATE HAS STATE-PROVINCE RELATIONSHIPS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to foster and sustain international friendship, understanding, and goodwill between the people of Hawaii and the people of the Republic of the Philippines by requesting the Department of Education to support a student exchange program between students from Hawaii and students from the Republic of the Philippines.
