The purpose of this measure is to address the prohibitive
costs associated with respite service delivery and the lack of
transportation to and from respite sites by requesting the
Executive Office on Aging to:

- (1) Continue its research and investigation into timebanking
as a sustainable and alternative currency system, to
build social capital to enhance and strengthen Hawaii's
respite system; and
- (2) Submit a report on its findings and recommendations,
including any proposed legislation, to the Legislature
prior to the 2014 Regular Session.

The Executive Office on Aging, Community Alliance for Mental
Health, and United Self Help supported this measure.
