RESERVES WHO DECLINE HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE THROUGH THE

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to urge the Board of Trustees  
of the Hawaii Employer-Union Health Benefits Trust Fund to pay the  
TRICARE Reserve Select premium for eligible state and county  
employees who:

- (1) Are members of the National Guard and Reserves; and
- (2) Decline health insurance coverage through the Hawaii  
Employer-Union Health Benefits Trust Fund and instead  
opt for health insurance coverage through the federally-  
administered TRICARE Reserve Select.

The State Representative of the Thirty-Third Representative  
District supported this measure. The Hawaii Employer-Union Health  
Benefits Trust Fund Board of Trustees opposed this measure.
