Your Committee on Veterans, Military, & International Affairs, & Culture and the Arts, to which was referred H.R. No. 148 entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION URGING THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES AND CONGRESS TO SUPPORT AND PASS THE FILIPINO VETERANS FAMILY REUNIFICATION ACT OF 2013,"
