The purpose of this measure is to improve the efficiency of  
and provide flexibility to the Kaho'olawe Island Reserve Commission  
by granting the Kaho'olawe Island Reserve Commission a permanent  
exemption from the procurement code for the procurement of food or  
fuel products necessary to carry out its purposes.

The Kaho'olawe Island Reserve Commission testified in support  
of this measure. The State Procurement Office testified in  
opposition to this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by changing its  
effective date to June 30, 2013.
