Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.B. No. 891
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO NOTARIES PUBLIC,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to improve the regulation of
notaries public by clarifying the information required to be
included on a notary seal and authorizing the Attorney General,
through the adoption of rules pursuant to Chapter 91, Hawaii
Revised Statutes, to:

- (1) Adjust the fees to become a notary public or to renew a
notary commission; and
- (2) Establish and adjust other fees related to notaries
public.

The Department of the Attorney General supported this
measure.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Finance that is attached to this report, your
Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 891
and recommends that it pass Third Reading.
