Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.C.R. No. 92, S.D. 2, entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE COMPTROLLER TO ESTABLISH A TASK FORCE TO STUDY THE STATE PROCUREMENT CODE AND IDENTIFY AMENDMENTS THAT WOULD INCREASE ECONOMY, EFFICIENCY, EFFECTIVENESS, AND IMPARTIALITY IN THE PROCUREMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS,"

The purpose of this measure is to request the Comptroller to establish a task force to study the state procurement code and identify amendments that would increase economy, efficiency, effectiveness, and impartiality in the procurement of public works construction projects.
