RELATING TO THE LEGACY LAND CONSERVATION
PROGRAM.

WAL/AGR, FIN

Eliminates the requirement that state and county agencies and nonprofit land conservation organizations that receive legacy land funding must provide easements, deed restrictions, or covenants to county and federal natural resource conservation agencies. Effective 07/01/2050. (SD2)

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW




Testimony submitted will be placed on the legislative website after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the website should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
