The following measure(s) were previously heard on **February 4, 2013**.

<u>HB 174</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO FOOD LABELING. Requires, beginning 01/01/14, specific labeling for any food or raw agricultural commodity sold in the State that contains or was produced with a genetically engineered material.	AGR, CPC, FIN
<u>HB 97</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE PROTECTION OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS AGAINST INVASIVE SPECIES. Requires a permit from the department of agriculture to import, introduce, or develop a new species of genetically engineered organism. Allows the department after a public hearing to determine whether to grant a permit and under what conditions, if any, based on the department's determination of the level of risk presented to agriculture, horticulture, the environment, animal, or public health.	AGR, EEP, FIN
<u>HB 747</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. Exempts from the general excise tax amounts received for the slaughter and processing of poultry and livestock.	AGR, FIN
<u>HB 96</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO FARMS. Creates an income tax exemption on the first \$50,000 of income for family farms, family farm communities, and family farm cooperatives.	AGR, FIN
