Authorizes the Governor to appoint Commissioners of Deeds to take acknowledgments, proofs of execution, or oaths in specified jurisdictions related to the conveyance of timeshare properties located within the State. Exempts an owner's agreement with an attorney to file a claim as to identified property or contest the administrator's denial of a claim from the application of section 523A-25, Hawaii Revised Statutes. SCR 38 / SR 19 Status & Testimony	REQUESTING THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION TO ESTABLISH AND ACCELERATE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A COST SAVINGS INCENTIVE MECHANISM AS A FINANCIAL INCENTIVE TO MOTIVATE ELECTRIC UTILITIES TO REDUCE ENERGY COSTS.	CPN, WAM
