<u>HB 967</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY TECHNOLOGIES INCOME TAX CREDIT. Clarifies the renewable energy technologies income tax credit.	EEP, CPC, FIN
<u>HB 1408</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY. Provides tax credit rates and certification requirements for various renewable energy technologies. Requires an annual report from Department of Taxation and a 2017 study from the Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism.	EEP, FIN
<u>HB 756</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY. Provides a graduated reduction of rates for the renewable energy technologies tax credit for various types of renewable energy properties. Requires an annual report from Department of Taxation and a 2017 study from the Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism. Applies to taxable years after December 31, 2012.	EEP, CPC, FIN
<u>HB 497</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY. Amends the tax credit for solar energy systems. Defines certain types of solar energy systems and the tax credits applicable to each. Effective July 1, 2013; applicable to taxable years after December 31, 2013.	EEP, CPC, FIN
