<u>SB 1036</u> <u>(HSCR1137)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM PERSONNEL. Allows the Board of Trustees of the Employees' Retirement System, through its Administrator, to appoint one or more investment officers and changes the title of the "Administrator" of the system to "Executive Director."	LAB, FIN
<u>SB 332, SD1, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1134)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO WAGES. Requires employers to provide employees with specific wage and employer information in employees' pay records; requires employers to maintain accurate and timely wage recordkeeping. Effective July 1, 2113.	LAB, FIN
<u>SB 331, SD2, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1025)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO LABOR. Increases the hourly minimum wage to \$7.75 on January 1, 2014, \$8.25 on January 1, 2015, \$8.75 on January 1, 2016, and \$9.00 on January 1, 2017. Effective July 1, 2050.	LAB, FIN
<u>SB 877, SD1, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1032)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH HEARINGS. Authorizes the Hawaii labor relations board to provide written notice of hearing to all parties by first class mail at least fifteen days before the hearing and clarifies the board's powers for conducting appeals under chapter 396, Hawaii Revised Statutes. <u>SB 885, SD2, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1095)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING. Repeals language that prohibits parties from using arbitration to resolve impasses or disputes relating to the State and counties' contributions to the employer-union health benefits trust fund. Repeals the procedures parties are required to follow after an arbitration panel issues a decision and the understanding that members of bargaining units are prohibited from striking on the issue of state and county contributions to the employer-union health benefits trust fund. Makes housekeeping amendments relating to the scope of negotiations. Effective July 1, 2113.	LAB, FIN
<u>SB 883, SD2, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1027)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING. Creates a new bargaining unit (14) for state law enforcement officers and state and county ocean safety and water safety officers. Effective July 1, 2013.	LAB/PBS, FIN
<u>SB 895, SD1</u> <u>(HSCR1096)</u> <u>Status</u>	MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COST ITEMS. Appropriates funds for the employer-union health benefits trust fund costs for officers and employees within collective bargaining unit (2) and their excluded counterparts.	LAB, FIN
<u>SB 904, SD1</u> <u>(HSCR1090)</u> <u>Status</u>	MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COST ITEMS. PAPER: One copy to Room 306 in the State Capitol;


FAX: For testimony less than 5 pages in length, transmit to 1-800-535-3859 (for Neighbor Islander without a computer to submit testimony through the website); or
