Authorizes the HPHA to enter into agreements with the DPS to obtain the aid and cooperation of the sheriff division to provide security services to protect the residents, staff, buildings, and lands of the authority. Effective 07/01/2050. (SD1)

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
