SB 1227 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO HEALTH COVERAGE FOR BRAIN INJURIES. Requires certain insurance contracts and plans to provide coverage for survivors of brain injuries, including cognitive and neurocognitive therapy, neurobehavioral and neuropsychological testing or treatment, and necessary post-acute transition services or community reintegration activities for a period of at least six months from the date the injury occurred.	HTH/CPN, WAM
SB 650 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO HEALTH. Prohibits doctors, nurses, and pharmacists from prescribing long-acting opioid painkillers in emergency rooms. Prohibits doctors, nurses, and pharmacists in emergency rooms from prescribing more than a three-day supply of opioid painkillers. Prohibits doctors, nurses, and pharmacists in emergency rooms from refilling prescriptions for opioid painkillers that have been lost, stolen, or destroyed.	HTH/CPN, JDL
SB 1240 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO PEDIATRIC DENTAL HEALTH COVERAGE. Amends definition of "qualified patient" to include pediatric dental benefits as provided under the federal Affordable Care Act.	HTH/CPN, WAM
SB 1124 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE DIETITIAN LICENSURE SPECIAL FUND. Authorizes the Department of Health to expend fees from the Dietitian Licensure Special Fund to offset the expenses incurred relating to the licensing of dietitians.	HTH/CPN, WAM
