HB 1429  
Status

RELATING TO HEALTH.  
Directs the Departments of Health and Human Services to maintain an inventory of all community-based care facilities licensed or certified under their jurisdiction and their vacancies to facilitate the placement of individuals in community-based facilities.

HB 1432  
Status

RELATING TO AGING AND DISABILITY RESOURCE CENTERS.  
Appropriates funds to support a statewide aging and disability resource center with sites in each county. Effective July 1, 2013.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

Persons wishing to offer comments should submit testimony at least 24 hours prior to the hearing. Testimony should indicate:

- Testifier's name with position/title and organization;

PAPER: 5 copies (including an original) to Room 304 in the State Capitol;



Testimony submitted will be placed on the legislative website after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the website should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
