Provides exception to the twenty-five per cent limit for an owner's agreement with an attorney to maintain an action in circuit court upon approval of the court. Effective 07/01/2050. Broadens criminal trespass in the first degree to include a person who enters or remains unlawfully in or upon the premises of a public housing project after a reasonable request or warning to leave by housing authorities or a law enforcement officer; provided that no warning or request is necessary between certain times of day and if the public housing has signs to mark the boundaries of property and notify the public that the public housing project is closed to the public during certain hours.
