The following measure(s) were previously heard on **Tuesday, February 5, 2013.**

<u>HB 15</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO FERAL BIRDS. Provides a civil cause of action for personal injury or property damage proximately caused by a person who feeds feral birds.	JUD
<u>HB 619</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO FERAL BIRDS. Makes feeding feral birds that cause a common nuisance subject to a fine. Makes a second offense within five years a petty misdemeanor.	JUD

The following measure(s) were previously heard on **Friday, February 15, 2013.**

<u>HB 713, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR322)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO SOCIAL MEDIA. Prohibits employers from requiring employees and applicants for employment from disclosing personal account usernames or passwords. Creates an exception for law enforcement agencies conducting background checks of applicants for employment. (HB713 HD1)	LAB, JUD
<u>HB 568</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE ELECTIONS COMMISSION. Specifies the duty of the elections commission to provide oversight of the chief elections officer.	JUD



<u>HB 90, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR177)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO EMERGENCY RESPONSE VEHICLES. Establishes a temporary Emergency Response Vehicle Noise Task Force to determine the impact of the emergency response vehicle sirens in terms of excessive noise, the effect on public safety, and the relative effectiveness of the use of emergency lights instead of the use of sirens at night. Effective July 1, 2050. (HB90 HD1)	TRN, JUD
<u>HB 740</u> <u>(HSCR176)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO OPEN CONTAINERS OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS IN PUBLIC HOUSING. Prohibits the possession or storage of an open container holding intoxicating liquor on any sidewalk or common area within any public housing project under the jurisdiction of the Hawaii public housing authority	HSG, JUD
<u>HB 951</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE SERVICE OF PROCESS. Update the statutes to authorize persons authorized by the courts to serve legal process.	JUD
<u>HB 791</u> <u>(HSCR192)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO NONPROFIT CORPORATIONS. Adds a new section to clearly provide that directors of a nonprofit corporation shall have access to the books and records of the corporation to the extent reasonably related to their duties.	CPC, JUD
