Changes the representation of the appointed, non-organization representatives on the commission from residents of the islands of Kauai, Maui, Molokai, and Hawaii to residents of the counties of Kauai, Maui, and Hawaii. Repeals the commission's authority to appoint an arts program specialist. Authorizes the commission to appoint an executive director. Requires the executive director and clerk typist's salaries to be provided, in part, by the State.	THA/TEC, WAM

<a href="#"><u>SB 1171</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO THE REVIEW OF HISTORIC PRESERVATION PROJECTS. Authorizes the phased review of projects by the Department of Land and Natural Resources' State Historic Preservation Division to ensure consistency between state and federal law.	TEC/THA
