<u>HB 488</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO APPRAISALS. Requires valuation of public agricultural or aquacultural land to be based on the land's agricultural or aquacultural use; economic considerations, relevant risk factors, and societal benefits. In the case of disinterested appraisals, requires that costs greater than one year's existing rent shall be borne by DLNR.	WAL/AGR, FIN
<u>HB 846</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE OWNER-BUILDER EXEMPTION. Sets forth specific responsibilities of and protections for owner-builders exempted under chapter 444, Hawaii Revised Statutes.	WAL/AGR, CPC
<u>HB 1261</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. Amends the important agricultural land qualified agricultural cost tax credit to allow an additional fifteen per cent credit for drought mitigation. Deletes reference to a repealed special fund. Appropriates funds for staffing and consulting expenses.	AGR/WAL, FIN
<u>HB 1263</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO IRRIGATION. Authorizes the director of finance to issue GO bonds to finance improvements to various irrigation systems.	AGR/WAL, FIN

Submit testimony in ONE of the following ways:




Testimony submitted will be placed on the legislative website after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the website should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
