Increases from \$5 to \$10 the amount of authorized income tax check-off that may be designated payable from an individual's state income tax refund to certain special funds or accounts. Permits designation of check-off in the amount of \$5 or \$10 to the special funds or accounts specified. Effective 7/01/2030. (HD1)	WAM
<a href="#"><u>HB 425, HD1</u></a> <a href="#"><u>(HSCR582)</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO OFFERS IN COMPROMISE. Requires offers in compromise submitted to the department of taxation to be accompanied by certain payments. (HD1)	WAM
<a href="#"><u>HB 430, HD1</u></a> <a href="#"><u>(HSCR600)</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO TAXATION. Exempts charitable income tax deductions from the itemized deduction caps. Effective 07/01/2030. (HD1)	WAM
<a href="#"><u>HB 504, HD1</u></a> <a href="#"><u>(HSCR601)</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO STATE FUNDS. Amends criteria to be used in establishing and evaluating new special or revolving funds, requiring link between benefits sought and charges on users, and a clear link between program and revenue source. Effective 07/01/2030. (HD1)	WAM
