Requires lessors of rental motor vehicles to include an option to the lessee in the motor vehicle agreement to contribute a sum to the department of land and natural resources for the preservation and protection of the environment beginning July 1, 2015. Repeals July 1, 2018. (SD1)	CPN/WTL, WAM
<a href="#">HB 1374, HD1</a> <a href="#">(SSCR1038)</a> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a>	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Allows past performance to be factored into future bid selection of a contractor including a review of delays, cost overruns, corrective actions, and responses to notices of deficiencies. Effective January 1, 2020. (HB1374 HD1)	EGH, WAM
